

## DAY 12

# THE FEAR OF GOD, A LIFE INSURANCE THAT WE NEED

As we walk in the FEAR OF THE LORD, we will walk in Holiness which will bring light to our path, to find the joy and protection that endures in the midst of any circumstance. The fear of God is to revere God. Until we understand who God is, and develop a reverential fear towards Him, we cannot acquire true wisdom. True wisdom only comes from understanding who God is and that He is holy, just and sovereign. Hebrews 12:28 says: "So, receiving an immovable kingdom, let us have gratitude, and through it we serve God pleasing him with fear and reverence" The word "FEAR" in this verse is the Greek word "eulábeia" which means "fear reverent, pious "properly," clinging to what God calls good "We will not approach God casually, nor with a religious spirit, but with" godly fear".

The casual and carnal attitudes of the modern Church are about to change abruptly. The fear of God is being restored and as this holy and reverent fear of the Lord returns to God's people, the manifest presence of the Lord will also return. Expect to see God reveal himself in such magnitude and glory that people's mouths will open wide with the roar of the Lion of Judah. Do not expect less than amazing experiences.

Lana Vawser confirms my feeling with this word: "I have had numerous encounters with the Lord in recent months regarding the fearful God tsunami that is beginning to crash into the Body of Christ.

I have never felt the fear of the Lord in a season like the one I feel now. It is not being afraid of Him, it is a reverent fear of who He is and His majesty, His holiness, which leaves me undone. Through love and honor to Him and His Glory I can give my life and my everything with purity, integrity, humility and walk in complete

obedience to Him. There is a call from the Lord at this time to offer us again as living sacrifices for Him (Romans 12: 1-2).

The greatest movement of the Spirit of God, abundance, harvest, acceleration is upon us. The greatest days to see the Glory and Majesty of God are upon us and, unlike any other time, I feel the urgency and fear of God being a good administrator.

It is not an effort, it is not an unhealthy fear, it is a place to live near His heart and know His ways and act well with complete, total and radical obedience to Him, following His ways. Self-indulgence, sitting on the fence, living in gray areas and commitment are being treated right now. ”

**Proverbs 15:16** Amplified Bible (AMP)

Better is a little with the [reverent, worshipful] fear of the LORD Than great treasure and trouble with it.

**Proverbs 19:23** Amplified Bible (AMP)

The fear of the LORD *leads* to life, So that one may sleep satisfied, untouched by evil.

**Proverbs 14:26-27** Amplified Bible (AMP)

In the [reverent] fear of the LORD there is strong confidence,  
And His children will [always] have a place of refuge. The [reverent] fear of the LORD [that leads to obedience and worship] is a fountain of life,  
So that one may avoid the snares of death.

**Psalms 115:11** Amplified Bible (AMP)

You who [reverently] fear the LORD, trust in LORD; He is their help and their shield.

**Psalms 34:9** Amplified Bible (AMP) O [reverently] fear the LORD, you His saints (believers, holy ones); For to those who fear Him there is no want.

**Psalms 111:5** Amplified Bible (AMP)

He has given food to those who fear Him [with awe-inspired reverence];  
He will remember His covenant forever.

**Psalm 25:13-14** Amplified Bible (AMP)

His soul will dwell in prosperity *and* goodness, And his descendants will inherit the land. The secret [of the wise counsel] of the LORD is for those who fear Him, And He will let them know His covenant *and* reveal to them [through His word] its [deep, inner] meaning.

**Psalm 34:6-7** Amplified Bible (AMP)

This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him And saved him from all his troubles. The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him [with awe-inspired reverence and worship Him with obedience], And He rescues [each of] them.

**READINGS FOR JANUARY 17 - Hebrews 12: 18-29; Psalm 112; Deuteronomy 10:**

**12-13** Look for it like never before. Immerse yourself in His Word like never before. Ask for strategies and don't move until you hear it. Give your complete obedience living in the fear of God and you will see the greatest fruitfulness, acceleration, increase and movement of the Spirit of God in your life that you have never seen. Don't run away from the fear of God, hug him. Let the revelation of the fear of God grow in you. Tremble in amazement before Him, let the Spirit make him born in you. Do not be afraid of that. Living in that place so close to His heart knowing His ways, you will see His holiness and majesty, you will live in surrender to Him in a place where you will run and associate with Him as never before.

**LE'S PRAY:** Father I come to you in the name of Jesus, I humble myself seeking mercy and grace, I have read Your Word and I want to love you, fear you and honor you with all my heart. I apologize for living irreverently, I repent, cleanse me of all contamination of flesh and spirit, perfect me in holiness and in reverent

fear of God. I want to be a temple where you live, but above all make room in my heart. Amen
